

A BRIEF HISTORY OF ENUGU STATE

Enugu state is in the South-east geographical zone of Nigeria. It was created on 27th August 1991 with Enugu as its capital. The state derives its name Enugu (Hill top) from the capital city which was established in 1909 as small coal mining town.

The state is predominantly occupied by the Igbo Ethnic group with some pockets of Igala speaking communities of Ette in Igbo-Eze North L.G.A, Ogurugu and Ojor in Uzo-Uwani L.G.A respectively.

Enugu state shares boarders with Abia State and Imo State to south, Ebonyi to the East, Benue State to Northeast, Kogi to the North West and Anambra state to the west.

The state is located in a tropical rain forest zone with humid climate. Hon. Ifeanyi Ugwuayi is the Executive Governor of Enugu State. There are 17 local government area in Enugu State in which Nsukka is one of them.

BRIEF HISTORY OF UNN

The University of Nigeria Nsukka commonly referred to as UNN is a federal University located in Nsukka, Enugu State, Nigeria. It was founded by Nnamdi Azikiwe in 1955 and was formally opened on 7th October 1960. The University of Nigeria has three campuses, Nsukka, Enugu and Ituku-Ozalla.

The University of Nigeria was the first full-fledged indigenous and autonomous university in Nigeria, with the power to grant its own degree modeled upon the American educational system. It is the first land-grant university in Africa and one of the five elite universities in the country.

The University has four campuses – Nsukka (UNN), Enugu University of Nigeria Enugu Campus (UNEC), Ituku Ozalla (University Teaching Hospital UNTH) and Aba (University of Nigeria Aba Campus UNAC).

The main campus of the university is located on 871 hectares of hilly savannah in the town of Nsukka, about 80km north of Enugu and Enjoys a very pleasant and healthy climate. The Nsukka Campus houses nine (9) faculties, Enugu Campus houses 4 faculties UNTH is a teaching hospital attached to the university hosting the Faculty of Dentistry and health Sciences and Technology while the Aba Campus hosts the institute of Nigerian Languages. The current Vice Chancellor of the University is Prof. Benjamin C. Ozumba who has the burning desire to create a smart university.
