BREIF HISTORY OF JOS

Jos, a city located in the middle belt of Nigeria is the capital of Plateau State. The City is located on the Jos Plateau at an elevation of about 1238m above sea level within a Latitude 9° 65”N and Longitude 8° 53”East. During the British colonial rule, Jos was an important center for Tin mining, with an altitude of 4062ft (1217m above sea level. It enjoys a more temperate climate than most of the states in Nigeria, with monthly average temperature ranging from 21°C to 25°C from mild November to late January. Night time temperature drops as low as 11°C resulting to chilly weather. The City is located at the terminus of spur (1st built in 1915) of the railway junction linking the city of Bauchi and Zaria. It hosts the prestigious University of Jos founded in 1975; The UNESCO school of Museum Technicians; Open – air Museum of traditional architecture and the Jos Museum, which displays artifacts of the Nok Culture. It is an ancient city of culture and of course “the Home of Peace and Tourism”.
