1.	Microbiology Bill	i. The Council agreed with the submission made by the Institute to the Senate Committee on Establishment and Public Service
2.	Non adherence to quality standard in the running of Science Laboratory Technology (SLT) program at Kaduna Polytechnic	i. The Council's final decision on the restoration of the Institution to continue running of SLT programme will be based on the outcome of the joint NISLT/NBTE visitation to the Institution.
3.	Professional Examination and Membership mop up request	The Council discussed and agreed as follows: i. The Council considered SLT as Pure Professional Course ii. The Council approved the improved MPE for all graduates of Science Laboratory Technology (SLT) irrespective of their schools and affiliations before admitted into the profession iii. The Council agreed with some of the resolutions of the meeting with Heads of SLT department in both Polytechnics and Universities that was held on 9 th and 10 th March 2022 at NISLT HQ except that of the Non SLT professionals. The Non SLT Lecturers will be given Ordinary Membership ONLY but cannot cross to Associateship unless they study SLT and partake in the prescribed MPE for professionalism. iv. Centers for the MPE were approved v. The Examination dates were also approved and due to commence in July 2022
4.	Membership revalidation	i. The Council considered the appeal letters from Members /ASLTON and approved 31 st December 2022 as deadline

	deadline	for revalidation.
5.	Monitoring and Evaluation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Council members were enjoined to compile list of Science Laboratories in their zone for informed decision. ii. The new Council Members/ASLTON leaders should be trained before full implementation. iii. The Council appreciated efforts made by NISLT by registering 37 Science Laboratories in the area of Science, Environment and Petrochemicals in the 1st quarter of 2022
6.	Scheme of Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Council directed NISLT to investigate what caused the delay in releasing the Scheme of Service as Promised by HoS and report back at the next Council meeting
7.	MLS vs SLT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Council agreed with steps taken by NISLT, FMSTI and FMJ in resolving this matter that occurred regularly.
8.	Request letter from Alhaji Gidado and Prince Gisilanbe	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Council agreed on the final result of the ASLTON NEC on the nomination list sent to FMSTI. They were asked to wait for the next Nomination so as to serve as deterrent to others in future.
9.	Council Nomination Guidelines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Council set up a Committee that will work with NISLT Stakeholders and ASLTON to come out with very robust and acceptable guidelines for nomination to minimize unnecessary factors.
