

| 1. | Non adherence to quality standard in the running of Science Laboratory Technology (SLT) program at Kaduna Polytechnic | i. The Council's final decision on the restoration of the Institution to continue the running of SLT programme was that the NW Zonal Council Representative, Alhaji Adamu Abubakar should contact the Head of Department of SLT at Kaduna Polytechnic and advise the department to write an apology letter to NISLT stating that they are ready to comply with the procedures expected for the running of SLT Programme so that the issues could be resolved finally. |
| 2. | Professional Examination and Membership mop up request | i) The Council agreed that the Institute should continue with the on-going Membership Professional Examination (MPE) as approved at the 32 nd Council meeting for the external candidates and approved for internal candidates scheduled between October and November 2023. ii) Council approved the Final results of the First and second Modules of the MPE as precursor for professional licensure with their induction proposed for July 2023. iii) Meeting of Dean's and HoD's SLT was approved to hold on 9 th June 2023 to deliberate on the modality of the examination for internal candidates before proceeding for their NYSC. iv) Approval was also given by Council for induction of graduates from Polytechnic and Universities. |
| 3. | Membership revalidation deadline | The Council considered the appeal by ASLTON for extension of revalidation of Membership till December 2023. |
| 4. | Monitoring and Evaluation | The Council directed that the NISLT Procurement unit should contact the Company handling the Monitoring and Evaluation for release of fund for its implementation in batches. |
| 5. | Scheme of Service | The Council directed ASLTON to take over the issue as promised since it involves political will after the resubmission of the enhanced Scheme of Service for Science Laboratory Technologists/Scientists as requested by HoS. |
| 6. | Council Nomination Guidelines | The Council considered and approved the report of the Council Committee on Council Nomination Guidelines. The Committee is to work with NISLT Stakeholders and ASLTON to come up with robust and acceptable guidelines for nomination into Council of the Institute. The Committee Chairman is to report to Council after working with ASLTON Leadership. |

| 9. | ASLTON Clearance on Annual Professional license issuance & renewal | The Council considered and approved that there should be a Desk Officer from NISLT ASLTON branch that will collect ASLTON due on behalf of ASLTON prior issuance of ALP and consented by ASLTON National. This will be required before Annual Professional license is issued. |
| 10. | NISLT-CLINOTECH MOU | Council directed that a letter should be written to CLINOTECH on the Institute's intention to terminate the MOU due to their failure to utilize the NISLT facility in Abuja office. |
| 11. | Laboratory Upgrading | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i) Council noted the completion of upgraded MSL with the new equipment and directed that the equipment should be engraved while fliers should be produced on the services to be rendered. ii) Council approved the proposed commissioning of the upgraded MSL in July 2023. |
| 12. | Official seal of the Institute | Industrial branch of ASLTON were informed on the ongoing usage of the Institute Seal on the Certificate of Analysis by members. |
